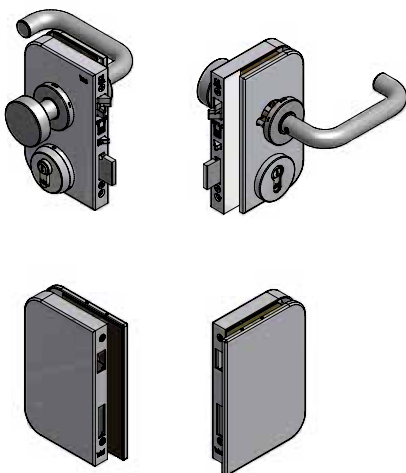
Panic and risks must be surmountable. That's what the OFFICE Junior SVP 5000 was developed for. The new lock in self-locking emergency escape design easily satisfies DIN EN 179, as well as the insurance-compliance requirements. You can quickly pass from the inside to the outside using the easy-moving lever handle. Upon closing, the bolt automatically moves into the strike plate and therefore ensures convenient safety – it is, quite simply, a sophisticated mechanism. Also ideal for all those looking to upgrade.

Security with method

The panic lock is easily integrated. It perfectly matches the dormakaba fittings and subtly blends into the existing interior. But it also sets a stylistic accent. Behind the shapely and secure unit for glass doors, there hides a solid mechanism. Even though the design appears to be lightweight, the lock has an impressively long service life and reliability even under high stress. Secure is prettier.

Security, point by point:

- Well-shaped and secure unit for glass doors – also in toughened glass assemblies – with glass thickness of 8 – 12 mm
- Self-locking panic lock with mechanical sequential control
- Insurance-compliant lock
- Panic function (E) tested and certified, standard-conformant according to DIN EN 179
- Can be upgraded without any difficulty, does not require wiring (standard OFFICE glass preparation)
- Universal trip latch
- Simple panic unlocking using the lever handle from inside
- Change to unlocking with a key from outside
- Inclusive knob / lever handle set with fixed knob
- Suitable for rebate depths of 26 mm and more in glass thickness of 8 mm (in case of greater glass thickness, a correspondingly higher rebate depth is required)
- Can also be delivered in fitting strike box (occasional door must be locked)
